



- 5 Pregnant/Post-partum individuals referred to MaineMOM








#### Year 1: Liaison Referrals by Service Type




#### Year 1: OPTIONS Emergency Co-Response Compared to Post Overdose Follow-up Response




# Year 1: Proactive Referrals to Liaisons by Providers, First Responders, Family and Friends vs. Self-Referrals


OPTIONS Referral to Liaison Type Project-to-Date








